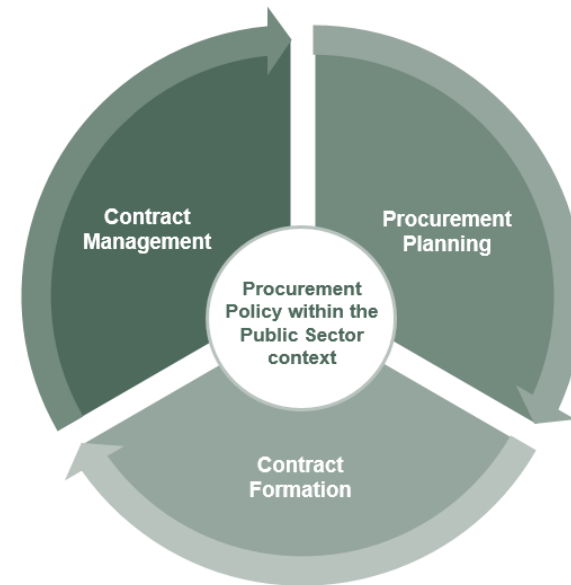

Sector Engagement

The following engagement methods are used to identify and prioritise development requirements for the public sector:

- Agency Self-Assessment responses
- Capability Needs Analysis – Sector Survey
- Individual agency requests and questions
- Chief Procurement Officers forum
- Agency Procurement Managers forum
- State Supply Commission audit reports

Core Public Sector Service Offerings



Government Procurement offers capability training and resources aimed at government agency staff who procure goods and services, information and communications technology, and community services.

The suite of resources are aligned to the Procurement Competency Matrix which identifies and defines the competencies required by procurement professionals in the Western Australian public sector. The Procurement Competency Matrix is structured around:

- the **procurement lifecycle**, and the central **procurement policy framework**, outlined above; and
- the **role types** below.



Capability Resources

A number of resources to support and define expectations for procurement staff have been developed, including the following:

Templates and Guides:

Government Procurement provides a suite of procurement templates and practice guides to assist and guide agency staff in procurement practice. These are administered by the Procurement Policy and Governance and the Funding and Contracting Services teams within the Strategic Advisory Services directorate.

Other Service Offerings

Government Procurement offers a number of development programs and resources to the public sector that are procurement related, but do not explicitly fit in with the procurement lifecycle and role types from the Procurement Competency Matrix. These service offerings are covered by the Procurement Capability Framework, including:
